ECG Electrode Pilot	Melody/K aplan		There have been 16 responses so far. The overall rating was 1.9 out of 5. The last survey response was from 3/8. Melody will reach out to Kaplan to determine if they are done with the Curaplex electrodes. There has only been 1 response evaluating the Curaplex electrodes.  There have been issues noted about the electrodes not being sticky enough, the packaging of the electrodes requires wasting of electrodes and there is no easy way to save the electrodes as it is not perforated, the electrodes being too large, etc. 75% of people would not recommend switching to the zoll rectangular electrodes.

VL Training Plan/Roll-out	Dr. Jacobsen	VL education roll-out will require several different methods. We will plan to go live for VL on Jan. 1st. Provider's must be credentialed in order use VL. Also, if a provider is not credentialed by Jan. 1st, they can still use DL they would just not be able to use VL.  We would like to have a meeting with this group and the education committee to discuss needs for training, equipment, and a way to accomplish this training and roll-out.  Life/form "Airway Larry" Management Trainer (\$863.99) is what Pagano used to create his SALAD trainer. He agreed to convert these to a SALAD trainers for agencies. There are SALAD trainers that can be purchased, but they are not on a board and it is more expensive. They also have a tendency to leak contents.  OMD met with MedStar to learn how they implemented VL.  We also have a meeting with JIMS this week to discuss VL video storage, uploading, and sharing.
